SPHERE OF INFLUENCE REVISION - CITY OF CARPINTERIA

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a meeting of the Santa Barbara Local Agency Formation Commission will be held on **Thursday, February 4, 2016 at 1:00 p.m.** at the Joseph Centeno Betteravia Government Administration Building, 511 East Lakeview Parkway, Santa Maria, California.

The City of Carpinteria is requesting that two separate areas involving three parcels be removed from the City's sphere of influence. Area I: APN 001-080-033 and APN 001-180-026. This area is part of the recently approved Linden Avenue and Casitas Pass Road interchanges and Via Real Extension Improvements project, an accompanying Local Coastal Program Amendment created the Whitney Site Agricultural Overlay District within the City's Zoning Code. A requirement is that the City apply to LAFCO to remove the two agricultural parcels form the City sphere of influence. Area II: Roughly half of the Carpinteria Cemetery Property (APN 005-430-050) is within the City's sphere of influence. The City believes that this may be a mapping error and that the entire Cemetery property most appropriately should be outside the City's sphere of influence.

<u>Remote Testimony is Permitted</u> - Persons may address the Commission in person or by using the remote video testimony system at the Board of Supervisors Hearing Room located at 105 East Anapamu Street, Fourth Floor, Santa Barbara.

<u>Disclosure of Campaign Contributions</u> – LAFCO Commissioners are disqualified and are not able to participate in proceedings involving an "entitlement for use" if, within the 12 months preceding the LAFCO decision, the Commissioner received more than \$250 in campaign contributions from the applicant, an agent of the applicant or an financially interested person who actively supports or opposes the LAFCO decision on this matter.

Those who have made such contributions are required to disclose that fact for the official record of the proceedings. Disclosures must include the amount of the contribution and the recipient Commissioner and may be made either in writing to the Executive Officer of the Commission prior to the hearing or by an oral declaration at the time of the hearing.

The foregoing requirements are set forth in the Political Reform Act of 1974, specifically in Government Code section 84308.
