

Persons may address the Commission on any matter listed on the agenda by completing and delivering to the Clerk a speaker slip before the item is considered. Matters not listed on the agenda may be addressed during the public comment period at the conclusion of the administrative agenda.

Remote participation by members of the Commission may be allowed under AB 2449, Government Code section 56953 (f) through (k), when applicable.

Consent Calendar

All matters listed hereunder constitute a Consent Agenda and will be acted upon by a single roll call vote of the Commission. Matters listed on the Consent Calendar will be read only on the request of a member of the Commission or the public, in which event, at the discretion of the Chair or a majority vote of the Commission, the matter shall be removed from the Consent Calendar and considered as a separate item. Members of the public may speak on any item listed on the Consent Calendar.

- 1) Receive and file a report on Transactions for October through November, 2025.
- 2) Approve the 2026 Santa Barbara Local Agency Formation Commission Regular Schedule of Meeting Dates and Locations (Gov. Code sec. 54954(a)).

Business Items

- 1) Consider the adoption of a service and sphere of influence review for the 19 agencies that provide Healthcare, Vector Control, Municipal Improvement, Harbor, Cemetery and Other Services Agencies in Santa County. Adoption of a Resolution includes the following actions:
 - a) Finding that the action is exempt from provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as “information collection” under Section 15306 of the State CEQA Guidelines and based on the determination that this action does not have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment (Section 15061(b)(3));
 - b) Determine, pursuant to Government Code Section 56425, that LAFCO is required to develop and determine a sphere of influence for the 19 affected agencies, and review and update, as necessary;

- c) Determine, pursuant to Government Code Section 56430, that LAFCO is required to conduct a service review before, or in conjunction with an action to establish or update a sphere of influence; and
- d) Adopt a Resolution approving the 2025 Countywide Healthcare, Vector Control, Municipal Improvement, Harbor, Cemetery and Other Services Agencies Municipal Services Review (MISC MSR) and Sphere of Influence Update with the following terms and conditions:
 1. Affirming the currently adopted Spheres of Influence of the Carpinteria Cemetery District, Goleta Cemetery District, Guadalupe Cemetery District, Lompoc Cemetery District, Los Alamos Cemetery District, Oak Hill Cemetery District, Santa Maria Cemetery District, Embarcadero Municipal Improvement District, Lompoc Healthcare District, Santa Barbara Mosquito & Vector Control District, and Isla Vista Community Services District, as shown on the map on Exhibits A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J & K, and;
 - e) Update the Municipal Service Review for seven Cemetery District (Carpinteria Cemetery District, Goleta Cemetery District, Guadalupe Cemetery District, Lompoc Cemetery District, Los Alamos Cemetery District, Oak Hill Cemetery District, Santa Maria Cemetery District), one Municipal Improvement District (EMID), one Healthcare District (Lompoc Healthcare District), one Mosquito and Vector Control District (Santa Barbara Mosquito & Vector Control District), one Community Services District (Isla Vista Community Services District), and eight Cities (Buellton, Carpinteria, Goleta, Guadalupe, Lompoc, Santa Barbara, Santa Maria, and Solvang).
- 2) Consider authorizing and granting authority to Executive Officer to enter into a Grant Agreement, and sub-agreements to implement the Work Plan, and Budget with California Department of Conservation regarding Sustainable Agricultural Lands Conservation Planning Grant for the Santa Barbara County Agriculture and Natural Resource Initiative.
- 3) Consider adoption of a resolution initiating the dissolution of County Service Area No. 32 and direct staff to process the proceeding.
