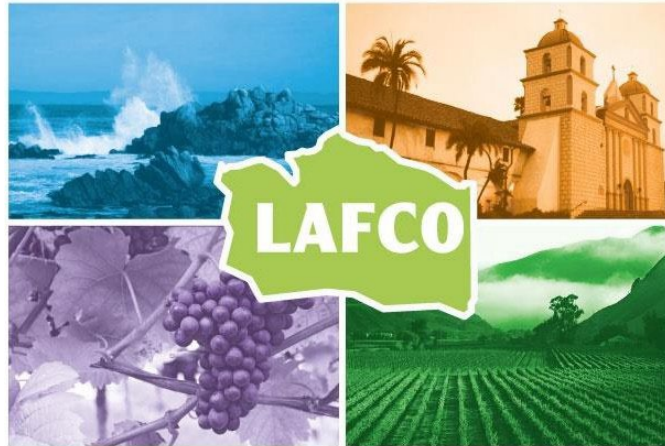

- 1) Consider recommendations regarding the Final Budget for Fiscal Year (FY) 2026-2027, and consider adoption of a Resolution that takes the following actions:
 - a. Review the Final Budget for FY 2026-2027, accept all public testimony and approve the Budget with any final changes and adjustments made by the Commission;
 - b. Pursuant to Government Code Section 56381(a), find that the Final Budget is adequate for the Commission to fulfill the purpose and programs of Chapter 3 (“Powers”) of Part 2 of the Cortese Knox Hertzberg Act;
 - c. Direct staff to distribute the Final Budget to the County, Cities, and Special Districts as required by Government Code Section 56381;
 - d. Notify the County Auditor to proceed pursuant to Government Code Section 56381(b) with apportionment of LAFCO costs among the County, Cities, and Special Districts; and
 - e. Update the Commission's contingency reserve policy.
