NOTICE OF REVISED FEE DEPOSIT SCHEDULE PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE 56383 AND 66016 ADOPTIONS OF AN UPDATED FEE DEPOSIT SCHEDULE AND HOURLY CHARGE RATES FOR PROJECT RELATED WORK PERFORMED BY LAFCO. AND, AUTHORIZE LAFCO TO ACCEPT CREDIT CARDS, DEBIT CARDS, OR ELECTRONIC FUNDS TRANSFERS AND TO IMPOSE CERTAIN FEES FOR THE USE OF THE CREDIT OR DEBIT CARD OR ELECTRONIC FUNDS TRANSFER NOT TO EXCEED THE COST INCURRED BY LAFCO

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a meeting of the Santa Barbara Local Agency Formation Commission will be held on **November 6, 2025 at 1:00 p.m.** At the hearing the Commission will consider the following items:

Summary. Revised Fee Deposit Schedule Pursuant to Government Code 56383 and 66016 adoptions of an updated fee deposit schedule and hourly charge rates for project related work performed by LAFCO. This schedule ensures fees collected will not exceed the cost of miscellaneous expenses of work performed attributable to specific projects. All costs will be documented. If work does not exceed the deposit amount, that portion of the deposit will be returned to the applicant.

In addition, the Commission will be asked to authorize LAFCO to impose certain fees on the holder of the credit card, debit card, or electronic funds to not exceed the costs incurred by Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) from the credit or debit card issuer or the processor of the electronic funds transfer in proving for payment by credit card, debit card, or electronic funds transfer.

Disclosure of Campaign Contributions – LAFCO Commissioners are disqualified and are not able to participate in proceedings involving an “entitlement for use” if, within the 12 months preceding the LAFCO decision, the Commissioner received more than \$250 in campaign contributions from the applicant, an agent of the applicant or a financially interested person who actively supports or opposes the LAFCO decision on this matter.

Persons participating in this proceeding who have made such contributions are required to disclose that fact for the official record of the proceedings. Disclosures must include the amount of the contribution and the recipient Commissioner and may be made either in writing to the Executive Officer of the Commission prior to the hearing or by an oral declaration at the time of the hearing. The foregoing requirements are set forth in the Political Reform Act of 1974, specifically in Government Code section 84308.
