### DISCUSSION

The 2025 CALAFCO Staff Workshop will be held in Temecula, CA on April 30-May 2, 2025. Staff will be attending the Workshop and will report back to the Commission at the May 8, 2025 meeting. 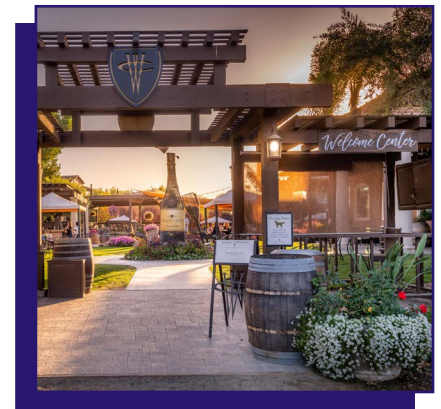
