- 3) Consider review of Santa Barbara LAFCO Commissioner Handbook Section 7; *Policy Guidelines and Standards* and Section 9; *LAFCO Budget and Financial Procedures* and provide direction to staff, as necessary – Recommend the Commission continue this item to the September 1, 2016 meeting.

Changes of Organization/Reorganizations

- 1) Consider recommendations regarding LAFCO application 15-05 for the Santa Barbara Museum of Natural History Reorganization: Annexation to the City of Santa Barbara/Detachment from the Mission Canyon Lighting District, the Santa Barbara County Fire Protection District, County Service Area 12, and County Service Area 32 and consider adoption of a Resolution that will take the following actions:
 - a) Find that the proposal is categorically exempt from environmental review under the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines Sections 15301, 15303, 15305, 15307, 15319, 15333, and 15061(b)(3);

- b) Approve the proposal, known as the Santa Barbara Museum of Natural History Reorganization: involving Annexation to the City of Santa Barbara/Detachment from the Mission Canyon Lighting District, the Santa Barbara County Fire Protection District, County Service Area 12, and County Service Area 32;
- c) Approve the Santa Barbara Museum of Natural History Reorganization subject to certain terms and conditions, including that the territory shall be liable for any existing or authorized taxes, charges, fees or assessments comparable to properties presently within the City of Santa Barbara;
- d) Find that the subject territory is uninhabited, all affected landowners have given written consent and the annexing agency has given written consent to the waiver of conducting authority proceedings; and
- e) Waive the conducting authority proceedings and complete the reorganization.
