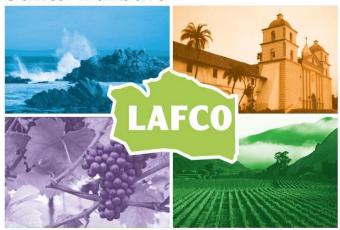

 - a) Find the proposal to be Categorically Exempt (Class 3 and 19) from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15303(a) and 15319(b);

 - d) Waive the conducting authority proceedings and direct staff to complete the proceeding.
