CALAFCO Legislative Update

Good afternoon and Happy Friday Leg Team! Just a note on this Friday afternoon to give you a few leg updates.

This has been a very busy legislative week, and today was the last day for bills to pass out of fiscal committee (in their respective house). Here is a quick bullet-point update on the hot bills we are tracking:

- AB 2762 Omnibus passed Assembly floor today. Now going to Senate Gov & Finance Committee
- **AB 2156** Achadjian (JPAs) passed Senate Floor today, now going to Enrolled for preparation for the Governor's signature (a request from me is forthcoming for letters to the Gov for bill signature)
- **AB 1961** Eggman (Sustainable Farmland Strategies) Held in Appropriations Suspense today
- **AB 1521** Fox (Local Gov't Finance ERAF) Passed out of Appropriations today and going to Assembly floor
- AB 1739 Dickinson (Groundwater Basin Management) Passed out of Appropriations today and going to Assembly floor
- **AB 1527** Perea (Drinking water) Passed out of Appropriations today and going to Assembly floor our amendments are still pending.

Earlier this week CALAFCO participated in CSDA's Legislative Days Roundtable discussions, as CALAFCO hosted one of the roundtables. Thanks to Steve Lucas and Marjorie Blom who joined me for the morning. We had two good roundtables, with all but one of our visitors having representation on their LAFCo. Their areas were as far north as Humboldt and as far south as Orange. We chatted about current legislation of interest to both LAFCo and special districts, and answered lots of questions clarifying the powers of LAFCo. There was interest in the JPA discussion with some uncertainty about how some of them were feeling about LAFCo dipping their toe into that pool. In total we had about 20 people spend time with us. No surprise that the hot table was ACWA.

Also this week I spent a great deal of time talking about groundwater management legislation. Under separate email I will be sending you a full update on that topic.
