RECOMMENDATION

- 1) Consider Recommendations Regarding Updates of Existing Spheres of Influence, as follows:
  - a) Determine that the action is exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15061(b)(3), and
  - b) Adopt resolutions, that confirm the existing Spheres of Influence for the following special districts:
    - Cachuma Resource Conservation District
    - Carpinteria Valley Water District
    - Casmalia Community Services District
    - Cuyama Community Services District
    - Cuyama Valley Recreation and Park District
    - Embarcadero Municipal Improvement District
    - Isla Vista Recreation and Park District
    - Lompoc Valley Healthcare District
    - Los Alamos Community Services District
    - Mission Hills Community Services District
    - Mosquito and Vector Management District
    - Montecito Fire Protection District
    - Montecito Water District

## DISCUSSION

### Background:

The law requires that Spheres of Influence be updated every five years. The Santa Barbara Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) received a report from its staff regarding a proposed program and schedule to review and update Spheres of Influence for the cities and special districts in Santa Barbara County.

After receiving the report and discussing the update program, the Commission directed the Executive Officer to confer with local agencies regarding whether changes necessitate new Municipal Service Reviews to update their Spheres of Influence. Updates will be prepared “as necessary” if there are significant changes to the city’s general plan, funding levels, or requested sphere of influence revisions.

### Special District Sphere of Influence Updates

On October 16, 2017, staff sent out Municipal Service Review/Sphere of Influence Update letters to the following special districts:

- Cuyama Resource Conservation District
- Casmalia Community Services District
- Cuyama Community Services District
- Cuyama Valley Recreation and Park District
- Embarcadero Municipal Improvement District
- Isla Vista Recreation and Park District
- Lompoc Valley Medical Center
- Los Alamos Community Services District
- Mission Hills Community Services District
- Mosquito and Vector Management District

In addition, Second Request Update Letters were also sent out to the following three special districts that did not respond to the LAFCO Staff Request Letters in 2016.

- Montecito Fire Protection District
- Montecito Water District
- Carpinteria Valley Water District

The deadline to either request that the Commission reaffirm the exiting spheres of influence, or request changes, was November 17, 2017.

### Current Situation

Within the timeframe, staff received responses from 8 of the 13 special districts requesting that the Commission confirm the exiting spheres of influence. Several districts requested that their Municipal Service Reviews also be updated to reflect the current service situations.

On December 12, 2017, staff followed up on the October 16, 2017 request letters to the 5 the districts that did not respond. Three districts responded almost immediately also requesting that the Commission confirm the exiting spheres of influence. They also that their Municipal Service Review information be updated to reflect the current service situations.


At the time of this staff report the remaining two special districts, the Carpinteria Valley Water District and the Mission Hills Community Services District have not responded to the information requests. For these two districts, staff is recommending that the Commission confirm the exiting spheres of influence. Should the two districts in the future request changed to their SOI/MSR, these request will be considered outside of today's action.

A Sphere of Influence is defined in Government Code §56076 as "...a plan for the probable physical boundaries and service area. . ." of a city or special district as adopted by LAFCO.

Government Code §56425 describes the determinations LAFCO must make in adopting spheres and the need for spheres to list types of services currently being provided by special districts.

Government Code §56430 directs LAFCO to prepare Municipal Service Reviews (MSRs) to help inform Commission decisions regarding adopting or updating SOIs.

The Commission has fulfilled its statutory requirement to adopt written MSR determinations and adopt SOIs for cities and special districts within the County.

LAFCO's enabling statute, the Cortese-Knox Local Government Reorganization Act, as revised in 2001 states "On or before January 1, 2008, and every five years thereafter, the commission shall, as necessary, review and update each sphere of influence." (Emphasis added)

The Commission-approved work plan directs the staff to confer with each city and special district to determine whether changes have occurred that would necessitate an in-depth MSR in conjunction with updating the agency's sphere.

If this initial review indicates no changes are needed in the current sphere, the LAFCO staff is to prepare a resolution for the Commission to confirm the existing sphere. If, on the other hand, the initial review indicates circumstances require a more detailed evaluation, the staff is to prepare a new MSR and SOI Update, with appropriate compliance with CEQA.

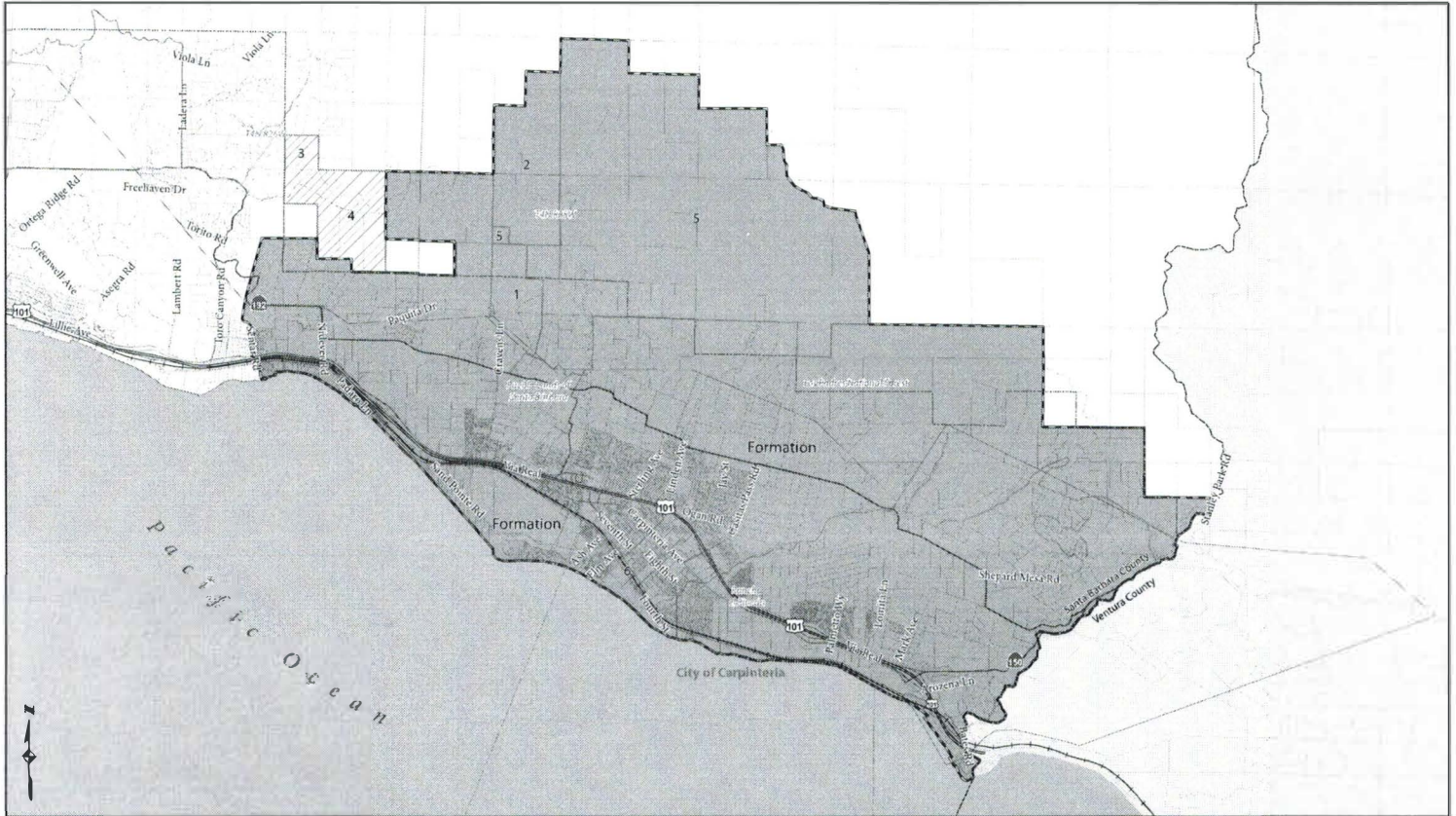

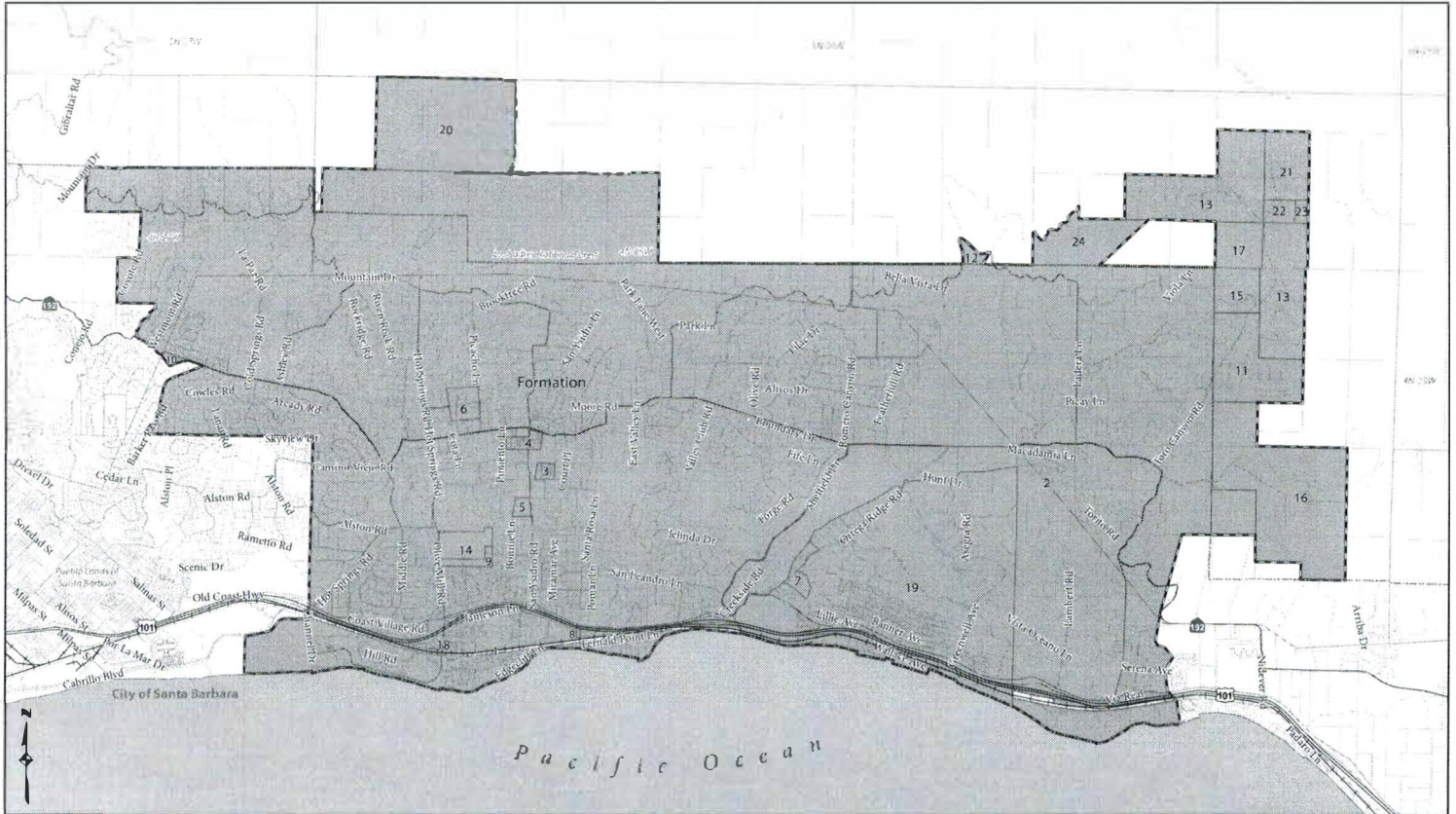
