### **Status of Municipal Service Reviews and Sphere of Influence Updates**

#### RECOMMENDATION

#### DISCUSSION

Following is a summary of progress made in approving Municipal Service Reviews and Updating Sphere of Influence.

#### Completed MSR and Sphere Updates

- Lompoc Area – Completed February 2, 2005.
- Santa Barbara/Goleta Valley - Completed September 1, 2005.  
The Commission will give further consideration this Spring to the area between the Cities of Goleta and Santa Barbara.
- Eastern South Coast Area – Completed November 3, 2005
- Santa Maria Valley Area – Completed on February 2, 2006 except for the Santa Maria Valley Water Conservation District, which has been continued to April 6.

#### Draft MSR and Sphere Updates have been distributed for review

- Santa Ynez Valley Agencies  
We anticipate Commission hearings on these agencies will be held on April 6, 2006.
- Cuyama Valley Agencies  
We anticipate Commission hearing on these agencies will be held on April 6, 2006.

- Casmalia Community Services District

We anticipate the Commission hearing on this agency will be held on April 6, 2006.

Cemetery Districts

We have received information from all seven Cemetery Districts. We anticipate scheduling Commission hearings on these MSRs/Sphere Updates on either May 4 or June 1.

Information has been requested from the following agencies

- Cachuma Resource Conservation District
- Los Alamos Community Services District.
- County Service Area No. 41 (Rancho Santa Rita)

We anticipate Commission hearings on these agencies may be held on May 4, 2006 or June 1.

- County Service Area No. 45 (Lompoc Library)

We don't have a planned hearing date in mind. It will depend on whether a decision is made to utilize this district to fund enhanced library services in the Vandenberg Village area.
