- 1) Consider recommendations regarding LAFCO File No. 20-01 for the 4 Sunrise Hill Lane expansion of the Sphere of Influence and Out-of-Agency Service Agreement for City of Santa Barbara to provide water and sewer services to an undeveloped residential parcel.
