

Consent Calendar

All matters listed hereunder constitute a Consent Agenda and will be acted upon by a single roll call vote of the Commission. Matters listed on the Consent Calendar will be read only on the request of a member of the Commission or the public, in which event the matter shall be removed from the Consent Calendar and considered as a separate item. Members of the public may speak on any item listed on the Consent Calendar.

- 1) Receive and file a report on Disbursements for February and March, 2023.
- 2) Receive and file the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Third Quarter report.
- 3) Continued from February 2, 2023. Consider application LAFCO File No. 22-07 for Bailey Avenue Sphere of Influence Amendment (APNs 093-070-084, 065 (the Bailey Property) and APNs 093-111-007, -008, -009, -010, -011, & -012 (the Bodger Property), and consider EIR No. 2008081032 and addenda. Proposed Resolution is for denial of the application.

Out of Agency Service Agreement

1) Consider recommendations regarding LAFCO application file No. 23-02 for an Out-of-Agency Service Agreement for the City of Santa Maria to provide potable water service to Ray Mutual Water Company located at Betteravia Road between Rayville Lane and A Street, in unincorporated area of Santa Barbara County west of the City of Santa Maria, CA 93456 (Betteravia Road right-of-way, APNs 111-030-005, -006, - 007, -008, -009, -011, -012, -013, & 111-040-010), and consider approval of an Agreement that includes the following actions and determinations:

- a) Find that the Commission has considered the Final Mitigated Negative Declaration prepared by the City of Santa Maria as Lead Agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Public Resources Code Section 21000 et seq., for the Ray Water Company Consolidation Project SP2021-0008;
- b) The Commission finds the service request to be in the best interests of the affected area. The Commission finds that the new potable water service to be provided responds to an existing threat to the health or safety of the public or residents of the affected territory;
- c) The landowner shall comply with all terms and conditions set forth in the Commission's resolution of approval, including the landowners shall execute and record an agreement approved by the Executive Officer that consents to any future annexation of the territory, which agreement shall enure to and bind all successors in interest to the property; and
- d) Said Out-of-Agency Service Agreement is for potable water service only and shall remain in effect until such time as an annexation is approved by the Commission.

Changes of Organization

- 1) Consider recommendations regarding LAFCO File No. 22-10 for the 3025 & 3035 Lucky Lane Annexation to the Santa Ynez Community Services District. The Commission will consider adoption of a Resolution that will take the following actions:
 - a) Find the project is exempt from the CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15319(b) Annexation of Individual Small Parcels for Facilities Exempt by Section 15303;
 - b) Find that the territory is uninhabited, all affected landowners have given consent to the annexation and the District has consented to waive the conducting authority proceedings;
 - c) Find the subject territory is uninhabited; all affected landowners have given written consent and the annexing agency has given written consent to the waiver of conducting authority proceedings; and;
 - d) Waive the conducting authority proceedings and direct the staff to complete the proceeding.

Business Items

1) Consider recommendations regarding the Proposed Budget for Fiscal Year (FY) 2023- 2024, as follows:

- a) Review the Proposed Budget for FY 2023-2024, accept all public testimony and approve the Proposed Budget as presented;
- b) Direct staff to distribute the approved Proposed Budget to Cities, Special Districts and the County as required by Government Code Section 56381; and
- c) Schedule a public hearing for May 4, 2023 to consider and adopt the Final Budget.
- 2) Consider a request from the Los Olivos Community Services District to extend the time to successfully conduct a Proposition 218 assessment as required by Condition B (vii) in the Resolution 17-03 approving formation on April 13, 2017.
