## Standard Sequence to Prepare Municipal Service Reviews And Adopt Spheres of Influence

Kick Off Convene meeting with affected local agencies to distribute Request for

First day Information forms, answer questions

60 days Local agencies gather and submit data

60 days LAFCO staff (a) checks facts, (b) follows-up on Requests for Information

and (c) identifies special studies if indicated by the provided data

Undertake initial studies and prepare environmental reporting as appropriate

for the specific Sphere of Influence updates

Write report

30 days Distribute draft report for local agency review prior to LAFCO hearing

(optional step depending on the circumstance)

Assemble the affected agencies to discuss the draft report, which may begin

a regional discussion.

60 days Noticed LAFCO public hearings to consider (a) Municipal Service Reviews

and (b) adopt updated Spheres of Influence

Post Hearing Update maps of local agency boundaries and Spheres of Influence

Evaluate the completed process to identify any lessons learned

## This process will be repeated for each of the Municipal Service Reviews study areas

**Priority 1A** Lompoc Area

**Priority 1B** Santa Maria Valley

Priority 2 Santa Barbara/Goleta Valley

**Priority 3** Eastern South Coast

**Priority 4** Santa Ynez Valley

Priority 5 Cuyama Valley

Other studies will be conduced where geographic areas do not appropriately address issues of water, airports, libraries, cemeteries, resource conservation or vector control services.
