SUBJECT: LAFCO Project and Meetings Update

This is an informational report. No action is necessary.

This is a periodic report of LAFCO staff activities. The last report was on January 28, 2012.

Status of Approved Proposals

Cavaletto Annexation to Goleta Sanitary District (LAFCO 12-5) was approved September 6. We will record this when the County Surveyor finds the map and legal description to be acceptable.

Palmer Annexation to Goleta Sanitary District (LAFCO 12-6) was approved November 1. We will record the annexation when the Goleta Sanitary District provides authorization to do so.

LAFCO Staff Meetings and Activities

- 1. On January 31 staff provided an "Introduction to LAFCO" for a representative of a newly elected County Supervisor, four city council members and seven special district directors, in addition to members of the Commission.
- 2. On February 5, at the request of the District Manager, staff presented an explanation of LAFCO to the Board of Directors of the Santa Barbara Metropolitan Transit District.
- 3. On February 7, at the request of a representative of a property owner, staff conferred with staffs of the Carpinteria and Summerland Sanitary Districts and landowners regarding a possible modification of the Districts' common boundaries in the Padaro Lane area.
- 4. The Commission met on February 7 in Santa Barbara.
- 5. On February 8, at my request, City of Lompoc staff and I met to discuss the potential Summit View Homes project annexation to the City.

- 6. Also on February 8, at his request, staff met with Sam Cohen, Government Specialist for Santa Ynez Band of Chumash Indians. We did not discuss Chumash properties but I responded to questions regarding LAFCO's preparation and adoption of Spheres of Influence and Municipal Service Reviews.
- 7. On February 12, at his request, staff conferred with Goleta Councilmember Jim Farr regarding the terms and conditions pertinent to the incorporation of the City of Goleta.
- 8. Also on February 12, at the City's request, staff conferred with the City of Goleta mayor and staff regarding possible adjustments of a common boundary shared with the City of Santa Barbara with respect to various public roadways.
- 9. On February 19, at the request of the City, staff presented the Twenty Year Report of LAFCO Activities to the City Council of the City of Goleta.
- 10. On February 25 staff attended part of the Special Districts Association dinner meeting to hear the discussion regarding Government Code Section 56133.
- 11. The next Commission meeting is scheduled for Thursday, March 7 in Santa Barbara.
