SUBJECT: Report on Pending Commissioner Elections and Appointments

DISCUSSION

The term of Regular Special District member Jay Freeman, will expire on March 1, 2022. Commissioners can continue to serve until they are re-elected or someone else is elected.

The CSDA Chapter met on January 24, 2022 to hold an election. Nominations for two candidates were received. A quorum was not achieved. So, staff will follow the mailed-ballot election process.

The Executive Officer will start a notice of a 60-day mailed ballot election for the two nominations received. A notice and ballots will be issued on February 10, 2022 for votes to be cast by April 11, 2022.

The term of Regular County Member Steve Lavagnino and Alternate County Member Das Williams is set to expire on March 1, 2022. The Board of Supervisors considered appointments of the Regular and Alternate County Member at their January 11, 2022 meeting. Direction was to return with appointments to LAFCO to fulfill the four-year term to March 1, 2026. This matter is tentatively scheduled for February 2022.

Staff will keep the Commission apprised of the progress of the Pending Commissioner Appointments and Elections.
