SPHERE OF INFLUENCE AMENDMENT AND ANNEXATION TO THE MONTECITO SANITARY DISTRICT (CALVIN)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a meeting of the Santa Barbara Local Agency Formation Commission will be held on **Thursday, November 6, 2014 at 1:00 p.m.** at the Joseph Centeno Betteravia Government Administration Building, Board Hearing Room, 511 East Lakeview Parkway, Santa Maria, California, Board of Supervisors Hearing Room, California to consider a Proposed Amendment to the Sphere of Influence and Annexation to the Montecito Sanitary District (Calvin).

<u>Location and Project</u> – The area proposed to be included in the sphere of influence and annexed to the Montecito Sanitary District is comprised of 4.2 acres including four parcels located at 330,300, and 100 South Sierra Vista Road, Montecito. Three of the parcels have single family homes. The remaining parcel is vacant (APN 013-165-009). The parcels are currently served by poorly functioning septic systems. The parcels would be connected to the district sewer line.

<u>Remote Testimony is Permitted</u> - Persons may address the Commission in person or by using the remote video testimony system at the Board of Supervisors Hearing Room located at 105 East Anapamu Street, Fourth Floor, Santa Barbara.

<u>Disclosure of Campaign Contributions</u> – LAFCO Commissioners are disqualified and are not able to participate in proceedings involving an "entitlement for use" if, within the 12 months preceding the LAFCO decision, the Commissioner received more than \$250 in campaign contributions from the applicant, an agent of the applicant or an financially interested person who actively supports or opposes the LAFCO decision on this matter.

Those who have made such contributions are required to disclose that fact for the official record of the proceedings. Disclosures must include the amount of the contribution and the recipient Commissioner and may be made either in writing to the Executive Officer of the Commission prior to the hearing or by an oral declaration at the time of the hearing.

The foregoing requirements are set forth in the Political Reform Act of 1974, specifically in Government Code section 84308.
