SPHERE OF INFLUENCE AMENDMENT AND ANNEXATION TO THE GOLETA SANITARY DISTRICT (BLICKLEY)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a meeting of the Santa Barbara Local Agency Formation Commission will be held on **Thursday, April 2, 2015 at 1:00 p.m.** in the Board of Supervisors Hearing Room, 105 East Anapamu Street, Fourth Floor, Santa Barbara, California, to consider a Proposed Amendment to the Sphere of Influence and Annexation to the Goleta Sanitary District (Blickley).

Location and Project – The area proposed to be included in the sphere of influence and annexed to the Goleta Sanitary District is comprised of 10.86 acres including two parcels located at 1310 San Antonio Creek Road and 1200 San Antonio Creek Road. APNs 059-440-012 and 059-440-014 respectively. The property owner are requesting annexation to provide sewer service to these parcels. The underlying project is a parcel map (14,797) which would increase two existing parcels to three parcels (a net increase of one parcel). The parcel map was reviewed and approved by the County of Santa Barbara Planning Commission and the applicant for the project is seeking to record the parcel map. One of the conditions for recordation is to annex into the Goleta Sanitary District and the annexation requires a sphere of influence change. As lead agency, the County of Santa Barbara prepared a Mitigated Negative Declaration (14NGD-00000-00010) dated June 4, 2014.

<u>Remote Testimony is Permitted</u> - Persons may address the Commission in person or by using the remote video testimony system in the Joseph Centeno Betteravia Government Administration Building, 511 East Lakeview Parkway, Santa Maria.

<u>Disclosure of Campaign Contributions</u> – LAFCO Commissioners are disqualified and are not able to participate in proceedings involving an "entitlement for use" if, within the 12 months preceding the LAFCO decision, the Commissioner received more than \$250 in campaign contributions from the applicant, an agent of the applicant or an financially interested person who actively supports or opposes the LAFCO decision on this matter.

Those who have made such contributions are required to disclose that fact for the official record of the proceedings. Disclosures must include the amount of the contribution and the recipient Commissioner and may be made either in writing to the Executive Officer of the Commission prior to the hearing or by an oral declaration at the time of the hearing.

The foregoing requirements are set forth in the Political Reform Act of 1974, specifically in Government Code section 84308.
